Hello and welcome to Hoe Valley School!

My name is Miss Still and I am the KS3 Senior Pastoral Lead here at Hoe Valley School. I hope to answer some questions you may have about starting secondary school.

Q How am I going to know my way around the school building?

A On transition day, 1st July 2025, you will have two Year 10 students that will assist you in finding your way around the school. In addition to this, when you start in September you are taught in tutor groups and therefore move around the school as a group. We also have signs at the top of each stairwell which let you know which subjects can be found on that floor.

Q How does break and lunch work?

A Break is for twenty minutes at 10.40-11.00am. Lunch time is at 12.50-1.40pm. Year 7 will be allowed to go to lunch five minutes early whilst you are settling in. You have a designated MUGA pitch to play on, as well as the field and outside the canteen. You are not permitted to be upstairs at any time during break or lunch.

Q What will my timetable look like?

A At Hoe Valley, our curriculum follows a 2 week timetable to ensure you have a broad and balanced learning experience before you choose your GCSE options. The first week is called "A" and the second is "B", and this cycle repeats every 2 weeks. Your form tutor will remind you every Monday morning which week it is, but you'll soon get it into your regular routine.

Q Where do I buy my uniform?

A You can access the uniform list on our Hoe Valley School website under the 'Year 6 Transition tab' as well as in our Family Handbook. Uniform items can be purchased from G&S Valentino. Q Are there after school clubs that I can take part in?

Q *When do I get my chromebook?*

A You will be given your chromebook on your first day of school, Friday 5th September 2025. Your chromebook is your responsibility and the only one you will be given until the end of Year 11, so you must look after it. Any damage is liable to be billed.

Q *How do I pay for my school lunches?*

A We are a cashless school! On your first day you will be asked to scan your finger. This will act as the code to your online Parent Pay account. Everytime you buy school lunch, instead of handing over cash, you will be asked to scan your finger and the money will automatically be deducted from your Parent Pay account. Please make sure your account is topped up with funds. You can, of course, bring in packed lunches from home.

Q *What can I bring in my lunch box?*

A We are a Nut Free school. Your packed lunch and snacks must not include anything containing nuts of any kind. We are also a healthy school and therefore fizzy drinks, sweets, chewing gum or energy drinks are prohibited.
