Students will be able to analyse media language and representations at a deeper level and confidently complete their GCSE journey.

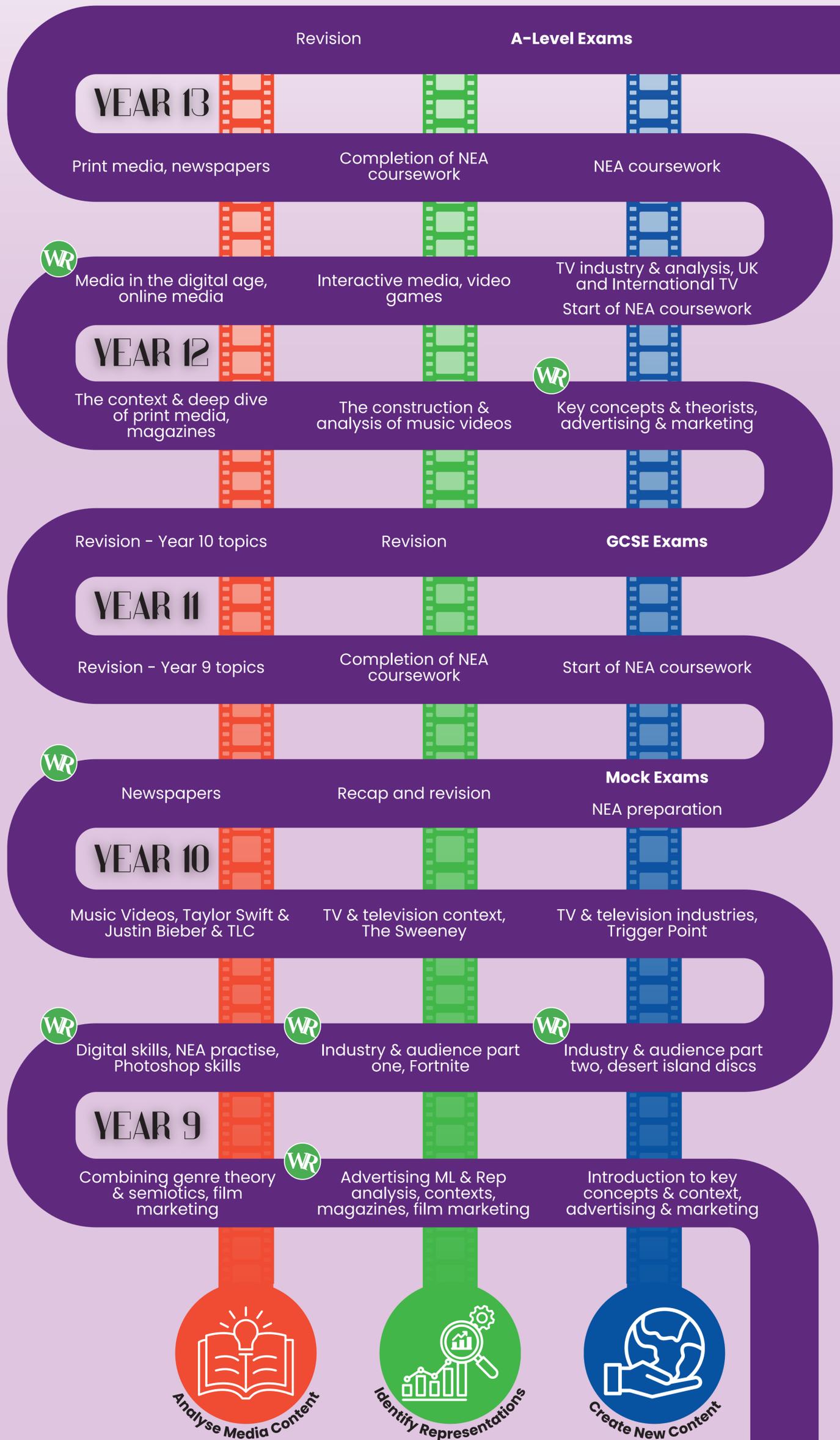
KS5
