



Hoe Valley School: Catch Up Premium Funding 2018/19

INTRODUCTION

The Government has made a commitment to provide additional funding to schools for each year 7 pupil who did not achieve expected levels in the Key Stage two SATs. The purpose of this funding is to enable schools to deliver additional support, such as individual tuition or intensive support in small groups, for those students who most need it.

We have used this extra funding to provide additional support students in year 7 in order quickly to bring them up to speed in both their literacy and numeracy so that they are able to reach their full potential at school.

Catch up Funding: £10, 000

Proportion of cohort: 26.6%

Number of students eligible for catch up funding: 40

Amount	Intervention	Impact
£5000	Small group Literacy intervention (Lexia)	100% of students improved their reading age significantly by at least 6 months or more. Exam data - 48% (12) have performed on target or above in their English exam, whilst 40% (10) one grade below target and 12% (3) two grades below target. Targets are FFT5.
£5000	Small group Numeracy intervention (Dynamo)	70% of students have significantly improved their number sense scores on the Dynamo assessment in Year 7. Exam data - 24% (7) have performed on target or above in Maths whilst 16% (5) are one grade below expected and 60% (18) are still performing below expected. Targets are FFT5.
