

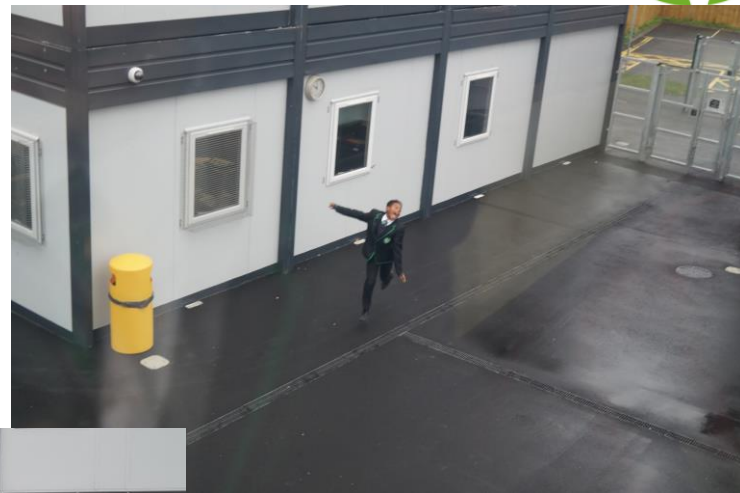

A view of the response to the HVS earthquake.



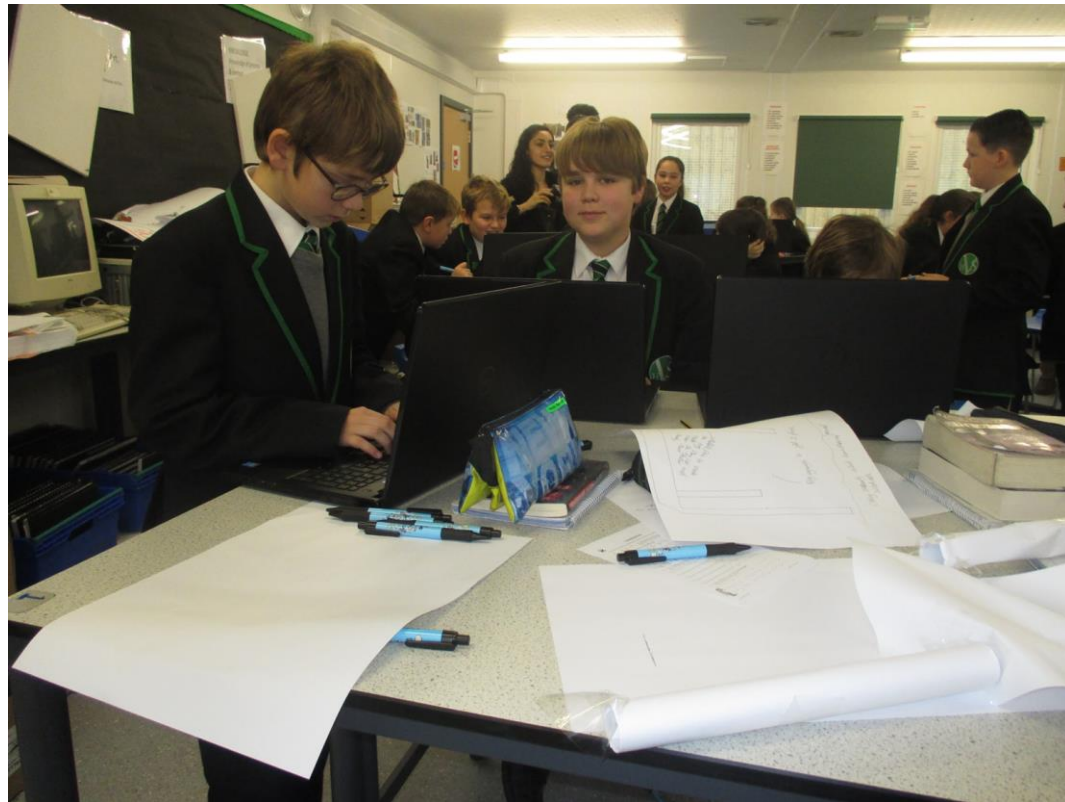
